In 1976 the junior college section was introduced and in 1981 the commerce faculty commenced both at the junior and degree college level. It is now known as R. J. College of Arts, Science and Commerce. From 1999-2000, the college has added a number of self financing courses like BMS, BBI, BSc in CS, IT, Biotechnology, MSc. in Computer Science and Bio-technology as well as add-on courses which hone the special skill of students. The college has been reaccredited with 'A' Grade by NAAC in 2014 with a CGPA 3.50.
