Suggestions made by BOS-

Introduce and expose students to Research –Group assignment should be given wherein students will collect information through field visits and later they may be asked to present the same. This will promote self learning and Presentation skills . As an incentive for such learning, it was proposed to give (subject to Principals approval) additional credit to students who undertook the research activity.

To improve the pass percentage in the subject it is necessary to identify slow learners and focus on improving their performance through remedial teaching and Peer learning. It is also necessary to document the peer learning process. Group counseling(Mentoring) to be provided to repeater students(ATKT) to help them clear exams .

To encourage students to take up internship so as to develop their on the job learning and skill development. – It is necessary to formalize the process.
