Minutes of the meeting

1. The syllabus for FY, SY and TYBSc Biotechnology which was revised and restructured was discussed by the members and passed.
2. It was emphasized that the transition of the topics is looked into very closely from FYBSc till the MSc level. Post-graduate syllabus was also approved.
3. Evaluation scheme or Paper pattern for undergraduate as well as post graduate was discussed and approved of with respect to theory and practical.
4. TYBSc syllabus with the applied component (Medical Lab Tech.) was discussed and passed.
5. Various suggestions such as inclusion of certain topics like incorporation of listening skills in FYBSc soft skills, introduction to Mass Spectroscopy were included.
6. In MSc sem III units were reshuffled on the BOS suggestion and topics like Pharmacovigilance, Trial monitoring, Ethics Committee / Regulatory bodies were added.
7. At places there were repetition of title / paper names which were changed.
8. Syllabus of Post-graduate diploma in Clinical studies, data management and medical writing and Regulatory Affairs were approved without any changes by the BOS.

9) All members felt that application of the subject should be emphasized and hence projects (short duration) should be encouraged. Hence projects in 7Y Sem VI exams will be continued.

10) FY and SY students will be motivated to take up internship in biotech related field in their summer vacation.

11) There being no other matter the meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.
