Objectives of the Meeting: Revision of syllabus and discussion of Examination paper pattern for F.Y.B.A, S.Y. & T.Y.B.A and M.A Part I and II in English along

with F.Y.B.Com and S.Y.B.A in the subject of Business Communication. Members Present: Dr. Neeta Chakravarty (HoD), Dr Pratima Das (Head, C.H.M. college; Vice Chancellor's Nominee), Dr. Dinesh Kumar (Vaze College: Subject Expert), Miss Poorva Vaishishta (Illustrious Alumni), Prof. Sharmila Jajodia, Prof.

Maria Shaikh.

Agenda:

1. Discussion of Examination paper pattern and Revision of syllabus for F.Y, S.Y. and T.Y.B.A in the subject of English to be implemented from the academic year 2018-2019.

2. Revision of syllabus and discussion of paper pattern of Communication Skills at F.Y.B.A. and Business Communication at S.Y.B.A (Applied Component) and

F.Y.B.Com to be implemented from the academic year 2018-2019.

3. Revision of M.A. Semester I, II, III and IV syllabi to be implemented from the academic year 2018-2019.

Suggestions: The following suggestions were made by the BOS members at the meeting:

1. F.Y.B.A (Communication Skills in English): The proposed syllabus and the Examination paper pattern was unanimously accepted without any changes.

2. F.Y.B.Com and S.Y.B.A (Business Communication): Deletion of Business Ethics from Sem1 of F.Y.B.Com and Sem3 of S.Y.B.A. and Crisis Management from Sem 2/4.

3. F.Y.B.A. (English Ancillary): The members suggested the inclusion of Mulk Raj Anand's The Untouchable instead of the present classic Pride and Prejudice in the syllabus for Sem 1. Also, Robert Bolt's The Man for all Seasons to be replaced with Vijay Tendulkar's Sakharam Binder in Sem 2.

4. S.Y.B.A.- II and III (English Ancillary): The members suggested the inclusion of Pre- Independence and Post Independence Novel in English and the removal of the term Indian Short Story from Unit 1 of Sem 3 in Paper II. The play Nagamandala by Girish Karnad was introduced in Sem 4 of Paper 2. The proposed syllabus of S.Y.B.A English Paper III was retained without any changes.

5. T.Y.B.A: Major changes in T.Y.B.A. (English) syllabus includes the addition of Christopher Marlowe's Dr Faustus instead of Shakespeare's Hamlet in Paper IV and the introduction of essays in Paper V in both semesters. The novel Emma and David Copperfield from Paper VII in SemV and Sem VI to be deleted and replaced with Frankenstein by Mary Shelley and William

Makepeace Thackeray's Vanity Fair. The play Pygmalion by George Bernard Shaw and the novel Animal Farm by George Orwell to be included in Paper VIII Sem V and VI respectively. The inclusion of Chandrashekhar Kambar: Jokumaraswami and Aristophanes: Lysistrata in Paper IX Sem V and Bertolt Bretch's The Caucausian Chalk Circle in Sem VI.

6. M.A. - 1: The essay Tradition and Individual Talent by T.S. Eliot and Umberto Eco's Casablanca: Cult Movies and Intertextual Collage to be included for study. Some topics were changed to include the novels Anne Radcliffe's The Mysteries of Udolpho and Thomas Hardy's Under the Greenwood Tree in Paper V Sem I and The Power and the Glory by Graham Green in Sem II. Christopher Fry's A Sleep of Prisoners was substituted with The Lady's not for Burning and Look Back in Anger by John Osborne was changed to Chicken Soup with Barley by Arnold Wesker in Sem I Paper XII - Drama.

7. M.A. II: Some texts were substituted to include Unaccustomed Earth by Jhumpa Lahiri and Dance like a Man by Mahesh Dattani in Sem III Paper II -Gendered Perspectives on Literature. Poems by Robert Frost in Sem III Paper III- 20th Century American and Kiran Nagarkar's Ravan and Eddie and Salman Rushdie's Haroun and the Sea of Stories Sem III Paper IV-Modern English Fiction were also included in the syllabus. Poems of Rabindranath Tagore were added in Sem III Paper V- Indian Writing in Translation. Latest texts as The Lion and the Jewel by Wole Soyinka have been prescribed in the syllabus.

8. Some suggestions were also given with respect to the Exam pattern of the

different papers discussed.

Decision: It was decided unanimously to accept the syllabi and Exam Pattern in the subjects of English (Anc), Communication Skills and Business Communication from FYBA/SYBA/TYBA/MA/FYBCom after incorporating the suggested changes.
