A meeting of the members of BOS in History was held on January 28, 2019, at 2.00pm in the Conference Room.

The following business was then transacted:

- The minutes of the previous BOS meeting were read out by the chairperson and approved by the Board.
- The chairperson explained briefly the changes made in the syllabus according to the suggestions received at the previous BOS meeting. The syllabus was successfully implemented for F.Y., S.Y. & T.Y.B.A in Semester I, III & II respectively.

- The syllabus of Applied Component Travel and Tourism was reviewed. It was successfully implemented in Semester III of SYBA
- The Travel & Tourism management Course Syllabus was reviewed and Semester I of Certificate and Advanced Diploma Course was successfully implemented.
- The Chairperson invited suggestions from the members regarding prospective Skill Enhancement course in History to be introduced from the academic year 2019 - 2020. Various suggestions were offered namely courses related to Urban Heritage, Numismatics, World Civilizations, Brahmi script, Modi script, Archival science and Introduction to competitive exams.
- The Chairperson informed the Board that the Internal and Semester End examinations for Semester I, III & II were successfully conducted according to the 60:40 pattern approved by the BOS. Question papers of Semester I, III & IV of classes F.Y, S.Y & T.Y.B.A were presented to the Board members for review. Members reviewed

the papers and conceded that the papers covered the syllabi and has been as per the paper pattern approved in the last BOs meeting. The Board members noted positively the use of quotes in the questions as it helps develop analytical skills of the students. One suggestion offered was to include short notes in the paper wherever possible, to help students learn to write concise answers. The members were informed that from January 2019 the college has opted for online mcq tests for F.Y. & S.Y IA I and IA II.

IA-I for T.Y.B.A History was conducted as online mcq test and IA II was to be in the form of projects, PPTs and assignments.

- The meeting ended with a vote of thanks by the chairperson.
