- Change in Android Mobile Programming practical was implemented in SEM-3 using **MIT App Inventor**.
- Software Testing practical is introduced in SEM-VI starting from the 20-21 batch.
- As proposed in the last BOS meeting, IT department is conducting a bridge course in Python for the new FYIT (2020-2021) Batch.

#### **4. Statistics from data collected on feedback on curriculum from students and alumni was presented.**

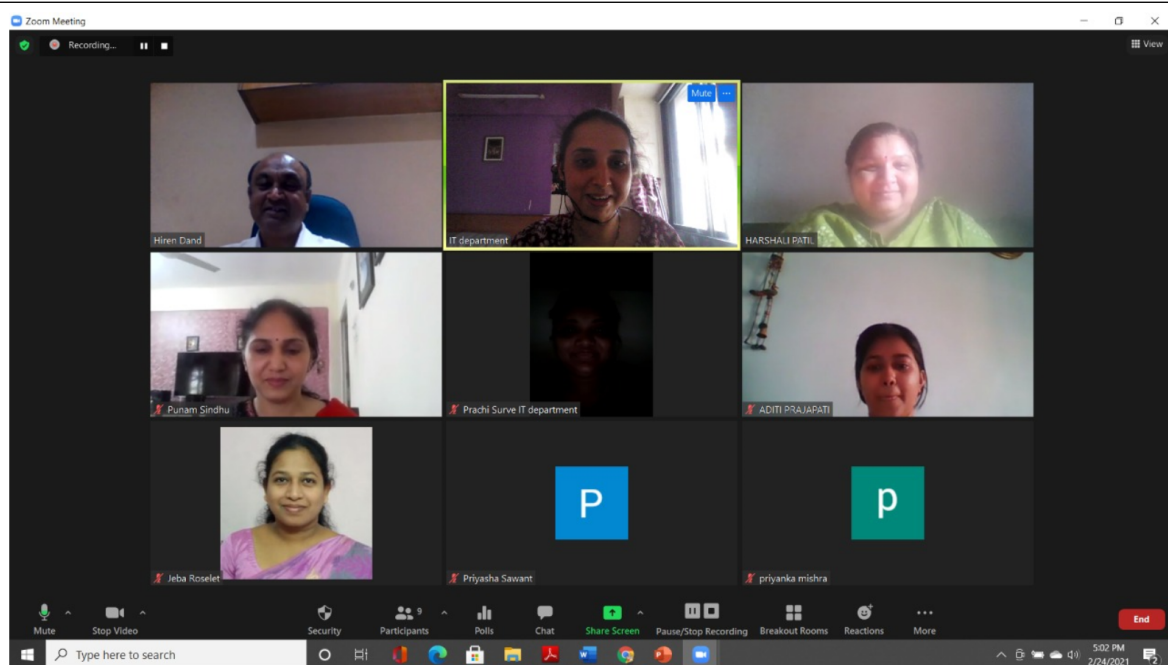

- b. Aptitude and other skills which will help them for securing better placements for Second Year (22-23 batch) for 2 credits.
- c. Employability skill enhancement in Third Year (23-24 batch) for 3 credits.

#### **6. Open discussion on revised syllabus for MSc-Part 1 with BOS members - Archana Madam walked through the distribution of credits and internal & external evaluation pattern of restructured syllabus for MSc Part-1 & Part-2.**

## 7. Suggestions from BOS Members-

- a. Nitin patil Sir suggested to introduce a course which will focus on project documentation.
- b. Harshali Patil ma'm discussed about the course on soft skills and human values.
- c. Harshali madam also suggested that students should be guided to identify, observe and give solutions to various Social activities or situations by developing web applications or giving a platform to people in the society for making the work easy and efficient. For eg. developing applications for e-waste collection or making people aware of environmental problems.
- d. Hiren Dand Sir gave his suggestion for offering elective subjects for PG course. Sir suggested that with a capacity of 20 students, if less than five students opt for an elective, it's difficult to offer it.
- e. Hiren Sir also suggested that internship for working students is little impractical.
