1. Approval of changes made in FYBA Moral Philosophy, in Semester I and II:

In Semester I, Unit II, one more orthodox school is added Samkhya Ethics and in Semester II, Unit IV, Business Ethics is clubbed with Corporate Social Responsibility, and Medical Ethics and Political Ethics are the topics added by deleting Professional Ethics.
