The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Ramniranjan Jhunjunwala College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Ghatkopar, Mumbai, organized two day national webinar on "NAAC Accreditation, A First Step Towards Achieving Excellence In Quality Education" on 16th and 17th January, 2021.

The webinar began with the welcome address delivered by the Principal of the college, Dr Himanshu Dawda. Dr Dawda began his speech by welcoming the important dignitaries, resource persons, fellow teachers and participants of different colleges from across the country. He informed the guest about the humble beginnings of the college and the significant stride the college has achieved from its inception in the field of academics. Dr Dawda said that

as an institution, 'we believed in evolving rather than just in growing' in order to fulfill the motto of the college *Knowledge is all Ambrosia*. He emphasized that quality education is a culture that is developed over a period of time and NAAC has played a crucial role in inculcating the values in the institutions of higher education. Dr Dawda also stated the role of UGC designed Paramarsh scheme based on the principle of 'Hub and Spoke' model in strengthening the symbiotic relationship between the mentee and mentoring institutions. He mentioned that Ramniranjan Jhunjhunwala College has taken the mentoring responsibility to guide and train five colleges so as to enable them to get accredited.

Dr Rajendra Singh, Honorary Secretary of the Hindi Vidya Prachar Samiti in his speech said that our college has always been conscious about the role of quality and value based education in shaping the future of the students.

Keynote Address

Date: 16th January, 2021 Time: 10:00 am – 11:00 am

Chief Guest: Dr Ganesh Anant Hegde, Adviser, NAAC Bangalore.

The keynote address was delivered by the Chief Guest Dr Ganesh Anant Hegde, Adviser, NAAC Bangalore. Dr Hegde in his keynote address addressed the significance of the core values of NAAC. He explained the procedure as to how an educational institution can apply for NAAC accreditation. It is important for every institution undergoing the accreditation process to visit the NAAC website and do detailed study in order to comprehensively understand the process and rules regarding accreditation. He discussed the seven stages involved in the entire process of accreditation. Dr Hegde discussed the meaning and significance of quantitative and qualitative metrics required to be submitted by institutions undergoing accreditation. He informed about the different application criteria to be followed by the autonomous colleges and standalone institutions while applying for NAAC accreditation. Dr Hegde observed that the revised accreditation framework has given more weightages to the quantitative metrics

in comparison to qualitative metrics. Hence it is important for the institution to have sound documentation practice while providing data validation and verification. In the light of the changing scenario NAAC had introduced new indicators like student satisfaction survey, alumni engagement and institutional distinctiveness. Dr Hegde suggested that every higher education institution applying for assessment and accreditation process must prepare an executive summary of not more than five thousand words highlighting the main features of the institution.

Discussing autonomous colleges Dr Hegde said that NAAC intends to make autonomous institutions dynamic in academics. The Criterion-1 indicators like curriculum design and development, academic flexibility, curriculum enrichment and feedback aims to judge the innovations of the autonomous institutions. He observed that teaching faculty must be clear while designing the curriculum and highlight the Programme outcomes, Programme specific outcome and course outcome. He also said the curriculum may be enriched by dividing the programme into core, elective and open elective courses and introducing add-on courses and value-added courses. In his concluding remarks Dr Hegde emphasized on the need of higher education institutions to contentiously enhance and improve research, innovation and extension activities.

Technical Session 1

Date: 16th January, 2021 Time : 11:15 am – 01:00 pm

Resource Person : Dr A.V Prasad, Assistant Advisor, NAAC

Dr Prasad in the first technical session elaborated on the Data Validation and Verification process (DVV), Student satisfaction survey and Peer team visit. Dr Prasad said DVV is the third stage in the accreditation process. At present, five external professional agencies have been hired by NAAC for the said purpose. The DVV partner verifies the extended profile questions, input for quantitative metrics, data templates and validity of the uploaded documents along

with external web sources like AISHE, NIRF, UGC and institutional websites. The DVV team can raise queries in cases like lack of supporting documents, data provided in the SSR is not matching with cross checked with external web sources. The concerned institution should answer online queries raised in the DVV. Generally a fifteen days timeline is provided for answering the queries. Dr Prasad stated the importance of referring to the Standard Operating Procedures document of the NAAC while creating the SSR or while answering the queries in the DVV. After the completion of the DVV report the institution can check the status report. It will inform the institution regarding the acceptance, recommendation or further clarification of the SSR.

Dr Prasad further explained the process of the student survey report. The NAAC team conducts an online survey of the students in order to elicit their responses pertaining to the teaching learning process. The students are randomly selected and surveyed. Confidentiality of their identities is maintained by the NAAC. The score of the survey is used only in the calculation of the final CGPA. Dr Prasad discussed the rules to be followed while entering and uploading the student's data.

Dr Prasad also spoke on the Peer team visit to the institution to be accredited. The main purpose of the peer team visit is to assess and verify the qualitative aspects of the self study report. The peer team in their visit examines the qualitative aspects, makes SWOT analysis and gives suggestions to improve the academic and administrative quality of the institution. Dr Prasad further informed the Dos and Don'ts to be followed by the institution during the actual three day visit of the NAAC peer team.

Technical Session 2.1

Date: 16th January, 2021. Time: 01:30 am – 02:30 pm

Resource Person: Dr Seema Ratnaparkhi, IQAC Coordinator, Ramniranjan Jhunjunwala College of Arts, Science and Commerce.

Dr Seema Ratnaparkhi, in the second session, spoke on Criterion I Curricular Aspect. She stated there are eleven questions of which three are qualitative and seven are quantitative questions. Dr Ratnaparkhi said effective curriculum delivery is a qualitative question for which an institution has to submit descriptive information like allotment of duties, planning timetable and meetings between Principal and teachers. Institutions should describe the content of the academic calendar along with a list of co curricular, extracurricular activities and examination schedules. Institutions must document information about their faculties involved in academic bodies of the universities. All documents related to appointment of teachers on academic bodies must be scanned and uploaded. On the academic flexibility indicator Dr Ratnaparkhi said institutions should provide information about choice based credit systems: programmes, courses and electives in accordance with the data template. Further, institutions should provide information about the certificate courses offered in the last five years. Dr Ratnaparkhi spoke on the importance of the curriculum enrichment indicator which is a qualitative indicator in which NAAC seeks information about cross-cutting issues related to professional ethics, gender, human values, environment and sustainability. Institutions have to provide information from the courses and syllabi that covers the above topics and provide documentary links. NAAC is also emphasizing how experiential learning is integrated in the academic courses like field work, projects and internships. Dr Ratnaparkhi stressed on the importance of feedback on syllabus from important stakeholders like students, alumni and employers. Institutions can design their own feedback forms and do regular reviews. Dr Ratnaparkhi showed the samples of feedback forms to the viewers. The session ended with discussion with the participants.

Technical Session 2.2

Date: 16th January, 2021. Time: 02.45 pm to 03.45 pm

Resource Person: Dr. Nandini Vaz Fernandes, Head & Associate Professor, P Chowgule College, Goa.

Dr Nandini Vaz Fernandes in the second technical session dealt with Criterion II: Teaching, Learning and Evaluation. She said the purpose of the above criterion is to ensure institutions provide equal opportunity to the students, formulate policies and strategies to cater to the diverse group of students. NAAC seeks to understand through this criterion about the effective teaching learning experiences of the institutions that includes interactive instructional techniques, teaching learning pedagogies, evaluation modes and promotion of higher order thinking. Dr Fernandes observed that NAAC aims to ensure that institutions have adequate teaching infrastructure like total number available teachers, competency in teaching methods and ability to learn new educational technologies and pedagogical skills. Dr Fernandes further said the five key indicators of Criterion II – student enrollment and profile, catering to student's diversity, teaching learning process, teacher profile and quality, evaluation process and reforms, students performance and learning outcome and student satisfaction survey enables one to understand the quality outcome of the institution. Dr Nandini concluded by saying educational institutions must not only teach but develop the cognitive capacities of the students to develop their independent thought process.

Technical Session 3.1

Date: 17th January, 2021. Time: 10.00 am to 11.00 am

Resource Person: Dr. Surendra Thakurdesai, Associate Professor, Gogate Joglekar College, Ratnagiri

Dr Thakurdesai in the technical session addressed the issues pertaining to Criterion 3. Dr Thakurdesai began his session by emphasizing on the importance of Standard Operating

Procedures provided by NAAC. He called the SOPs the bible which will give us an idea of the various criteria and indicators. Speaking about the research grants received from governmental and non governmental bodies, he said, the duration of the grant period must fit within the assessment period of the NAAC cycle. The institution must be aware of the new rule that grants given by its own trust or sister institution are not accepted by NAAC. He stated that while uploading information care must be taken to avoid errors which may be typographical or mismatch of information between the actual documents and what is uploaded or date and duration of the projects. Dr Thakurdesai observed that the sub criteria related Research, Innovation and Extension it is expected from the institution to have balance across the departments in matters of research. Institutions should promote all departments to undertake research activities so that a balanced statistical picture is reflected. Further, continuity in research is vital in order to have a good score in the above criteria. Regarding documentation of seminars, conferences and workshops, Dr Thakurdesai said, it is important to upload the reports of the events conducted on the institutional website as soon as possible. According to him, mentioning the uploading date on the report is a good practice. Similarly individual faculty must also inculcate good documentation practices in matters related to articles published in journals and books. As per journal publication is concerned it is important to take a screenshot of the website and URLs that will serve as an evidence. As per chapters or books are concerned, scanning the front page, author page, publication page and index page along with the chapter is an important documentary process. Finally, Dr Thakurdesai suggested that MOUs signed by the host institutions must be functional. It is important to conduct activities and events as per required by the MOU.

Technical Session 3.2 and 3.3

Date: 17th January, 2021. Time: 11.15 am to 12.15 pm & 12.30 pm to 01.30 pm

Resource Person: Prof. Dr. Nandkumar Sawant, P Chowgule College, Goa

Dr Sandkumar Sawant gave an elaborate explanation of Criteria 4 and Criteria 5. He said higher education in India is at crossroads and there is a higher expectation from the state, society and market to deliver quality education. Higher education institutions have to gear up their strength in order to meet the above expectations. He identified four core areas- competitiveness, teaching methodologies, employability and employability which needs to be focused and strengthened. He suggested putting focus on infrastructural facilities, human resources and robust curriculum. A seamless interface among the above three elements will result in a competitive and quality academic outcome. He also claimed that good infrastructure will benefit not just students and teachers but will benefit the whole society. He stated a well-equipped infrastructure among other things will have IT enabled classrooms, administrative units, auditorium, laboratories, staff rooms, prayer rooms, sit out area, parking sheds, common rooms etc. Giving an example of a library, Dr Sawant said, a good library is not merely a place to sit and read. Rather, it should become a knowledge centre wherein there is continuous flow of information, exchange of views and inception of new ideas. It must become an ecosystem for the production and dissemination of knowledge. Dr Sawant suggested using information technology by the institution in the delivery of academic, administrative and financial services. Institutions must design IT policy stating the goals, mission and strategies enabling them to harness and optimize the utility of the information technology. Institutions should create a database of the types of software, number of computers, sets of LMS, televisions, CCTVs, recording instruments etc for reference. A separate office or tech desk of information technology can be maintained to administer the issues relating to information technology.

Speaking on Criteria 5- Students support and Progression Dr Sawant said an institution of higher education must be able to imbibe graduate attributes among the students. The success

in the above endeavor automatically builds the brand image of the institution. He also emphasized the role of alumni in the brand building process. However, according to him, unlike the west India has not tapped the full potential of the alumni community. Further, he said, a robust student support system aims at augmenting the cognitive capacity, imparting technical and soft skills and inculcating human values in the students. Every institution must strive to support a system for students on the lines of equity, access and excellence. Dr Sawant stated apart from classroom studies experiential learning is essential for the healthy personality development of the students and herein the role of curricular, extracurricular, community services and extension activities plays an important role. Active participation in the above process will contribute to the nation building process.

Technical Session 4.1 and 4.2

Date: 17th January, 2021. Time: 02.00 pm to 03.00 pm & 03.15 pm to 04.15 pm

Resource Person: Dr Usha Mukundan, Director, Hindi Vidya Prachar Samiti

Dr Usha Mukundan explained the Criterion 6 and Criterion 7. Criterion 6 covers the issue of Governance, Leadership and Management. Dr Mukundan said while filling the descriptive indicator about the vision and mission statement of the institution it is important to restrict within the given word limit. Highlighting the importance of the logo of the institution, she said, the logo is a symbolic expression of the vision and mission of the college. She further claimed that the vision and mission of any institution must be dynamic to suit the changing demands of the educational system. The governance, institutional practices, administrative machinery and academic curriculum and teaching pedagogies must be reflective of the mission and vision statement. She further stated a well-designed feedback system with two ways communication will be able to cater to needs and requirements of the stakeholders of the institutions. Speaking about e-governance system, Dr Mukundan said, many areas including online admission of students, payment of fees, payment of salaries of the staff,

provident funds, conduct of examination, result processing, issuance of mark sheets etc comes within the ambit of e-governance. It is important to maintain records related to the above process like invoices of the software, contract documents with the vendors. On the criteria of faculty empowerment strategies, Dr Mukundan observed, institutions should make a list of all welfare measures, financial assistance, training programmes, welfare fund etc. She emphasized on the role of Internal Quality Assurance Cell in institutionalizing the quality practices, strategies, action plans and feedback system.

Dr Mukundan said Criteria 7 Institutional Values and Best Practices needs to be identified by the institution based on its practices, academic values and cultural norms. On gender equity indicators she said institution should include all measures and programmes aimed at promoting gender equity. Similarly all activities and measures undertaken for the promotion of environmental consciousness and sustainability should be identified and documented. Finally, she suggested that every institution should be able to identify a distinctive practice which can be considered as the unique selling proposition.

Resource Person: Dr Vijay Joshi, Chief Consultant, RUSA

Dr Joshi argued that higher education has entered into a new disruptive era wherein new sets of academic skills are required to meet the new challenges. In order to meet the new challenges NAAC is emphasizing on policy shift from top down regulation of higher education to self regulation. Capacity building, investment in the faculty, acquisition of new skill sets, innovation, broadening of vision is the key to sustain in the challenging times.
