**Discussed and Resolved:**

1. The committee was apprised of the syllabus and the changes proposed and approved by the earlier committee. The above committee also approved the syllabus and agreed to go through the same in detail and recommend changes for the next academic year, if required in the next BOS meeting.
2. The members were informed about the initiative taken by the college in general and the department in particular to identify 'Slow Learners' and measures to be taken to bring such students up-to-date with their syllabus. The same was appreciated by the members.

3. The committee was informed about the Financial Literacy courses conducted for the benefit of the students and they approved of the same. They also suggested following courses for the benefit of the students:

4. The committee was of the opinion that the students should be assigned projects and case studies.
5. The committee asked the department and the institute to determine 17 sustainable Development Goals.
