

Chemistry Department
Minutes of BOS Meeting held on Monday, 30th August 2021

- ❖ Online meeting of all the members of Board of Studies was convened by the BOS Chairman & Head of Chemistry Department, Dr. R. S. Dubey on Monday, 30th August 2021, at 05.30pm.

In the beginning, the Chairman welcomed all the members of BOS and placed the agenda for the deliberations of the members. Following deliberations were made as per the items of circulated agenda.

1. Approval of minutes of last BOS meeting held on Friday, 19th March 2021 was obtained by the chairman. Chairman then presented a power point presentation regarding current academic status of the department. An overview of various co-curricular activities conducted by the department till date was also given by the chairman. Planning of DBT star college activities to be conducted at departmental level in this academic year was also shared by the chairman.
2. Industry academic partnership of chemistry department was discussed at length by all the members. Following points were raised by the members:
 - A. External member, Dr S. D. Samant suggested to restructure certain experiments as per the actual requirement of various industries. He also stressed upon making students familiar with the needs of industry and provide more focused curriculum for the study.
 - B. Another external member Dr. R.M. Patil expressed the need of tie up of various industries with the department. He also suggested to accept small projects from the industries and complete it using research facilities available at the departmental level.
 - C. Our distinguished alumnus and external member of BOS committee, Dr. Ganesh Malvankar, insisted upon different industrial visits to bridge the gap between industry and academic institution. He also mentioned a need of certain common procedures such as effluent treatment at industrial level to be practically taught to the students.
 - D. All other BOS members unanimously agreed with all the above points.
3. Advantages and exact relevance in the changing time, of new national education policy document must be discussed at the college level academic council. Dr. S. D. Samant suggested to form a small group of teachers for the same.
