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On the auspicious day of Shri Krishna Janmashtami, 15th August 1938, the people of Ghatkopar and the surrounding suburbs witnessed the birth of Hindi Vidya Prachar Samiti, a brainchild of a visionary Late Shri Nandkishore Singh Jairamji. The Samiti was established with the objectives of catering to the educational needs of the Hindi speaking community. It made a humble beginning by starting a primary school, which gradually expanded into a full-fledged secondary school.

The Hindi High School with its high academic standards has carved for itself a place not only among leading secondary schools in Mumbai but also educational institutions imparting instructions in Hindi throughout Maharashtra. With its primary objectives achieved the Samiti decided to extend its frontiers and broaden its horizons. As a result, Ramniranjan Jhunjhunwala College came into existence in 1963, enabling a larger section of the society to take advantage of the facilities provided for higher education.

In 1976 the Junior College section was introduced and in 1981 the Commerce faculty commenced both at the Junior and Degree College level.



From 1999-2020 the College has added a number of self-financing courses like BMS, B.B.I, BAF, BAMMC, B.Sc. in C.S., I.T. & Biotechnology, M.Sc. in Computer Science, IT and Biotechnology. In the academic year 2020-2021 two new PG programs are being offered which are relevant to the recent times. These are M.Sc Data Science & Artificial Intelligence and M.Sc in Environmental Science & Disaster Management. To enrich the curriculum all departments offer value added courses leading to certificate, diploma and advance diploma.

The year 2014 saw a change in education system with greater emphasis being given to employability of youth. As an effort to realize the dream of Make in India, Digital India, Clean and Green India, we have started skill-based program supported by University Grants commission known as Bachelor in Vocation. There are two programs offered B.VOC Financial Markets and Services, B VOC in Real Estate Management.

In 2020-2021 college has established the NPTEL local chapter and linked with COURSERA so students are offered online certificate courses in cross disciplinary areas.

The college has been reaccredited with 'A' Grade by NAAC in 2014 with a CGPA 3.50 (Validity extended till 2023) and received the Best College Award (2007-2008) of the University of Mumbai. The College has been bestowed with IMC RAMKRISHNA BAJAJ PERFORMANCE EXCELLENCE TROPHY, 2010. The Principal of the college was awarded "Best Teacher" by Government of Maharashtra in 2011. Government of Maharashtra conferred the college with "JAAGAR JAANIVANCHA" (First in Mumbai Suburban- in 2013 and Second in Mumbai Suburban- in 2014) for safety of girls on campus.

AUTONOMOUS STATUS:

The College has been accorded Autonomous status by University Grants Commission (UGC) and University of Mumbai from the academic year 2018-19. However, the college will remain affiliated to University of Mumbai with an autonomous status.

AIMS & OBJECTIVES:

The RAMNIRANJAN JHUNJHUNWALA COLLEGE basically aims at not only catering to the academic excellence of the students but also providing them with facilities to develop their other inherent talents. Under the guidance of dedicated and devoted teachers, the students are able to achieve academic excellence along with character development.

For the overall development of the students, various associations conduct debates, elocutions, essay, quiz, photography, painting, singing, dancing competitions to name a few. Mental and Physical fitness of all RJites is ensured through these co-curricular and extra-curricular activities

All remaining verticals except for Open Elective (OE) orient around this vertical of Maj, and the Internship/Apprenticeship/ Field Project/Research Project in the Third year of study shall also be based on this vertical. You must therefore choose this vertical very carefully.

Expert Tips: It is you who has to decide Maj. Following your passion, liking for the subject, confidence of self study in addition to class room teaching that would help you to explore the scope of the subject.

Minor (Min.)

It is a vertical that strengthens the vertical of Maj. in terms of providing allied dimension to the core subject.

All subjects are interrelated as all subjects have originated from a common domain of knowledge which has elements of curiosity, utility and necessity and of course, all subjects ponder around understanding the wonders of the nature.

Expert Tips: Choose Min. subject as the one which you think is the subject that best complements your Maj. in enhancing your learning of Maj.

Open Elective (OE) or Generic Elective (GE)

This vertical is the highlight NEP2020 and you will be choosing it from the basket of OE at the beginning of the academic sessions.

It is the vertical that has to be from the faculty other than the Maj. and that is where it opens the doors for you becoming the knowledgeable and updated person in the society. If you classify all your daily routine activities, then you will realise that every single day, you deal with little bit of science (food, medicines, electricity, mobile), little bit of commerce (banking, shopping, trading, travelling) and a little bit of arts (reading, writing, communication, music, movie, painting). It is a vertical that gives you chance to step out of your core subject boundary in term of utility learning.

Expert Tips: Choose OE/GE based on your attitude towards the life and aptitude towards the learning new things.

Vocational and Skill Enhancement Course (VSEC)

This compulsory vertical includes Hands on Training corresponding mainly to the Maj. Subject. Whenever applicable, it will also include skill based or advanced laboratory practicals of Maj. This vertical primarily focus on the application oriented learning.

Expert Tips: make sure you have chosen your Maj. carefully.

Ability Enhancement Course (AEC)

This vertical aims at enhancing your linguistic and the communication skills.

It is a compulsory vertical because the effective communication is a key to success in life in every field. For the Arts and Science students, Communication skills and for Commerce students, Business Communication will be taught in this vertical.

Expert Tips: Good communication is the bridge between confusion and clarity.

Value Education Course (VEC)

This vertical will be offered only in the first year of under graduate program and shall primarily focus in sensitizing you to the importance of values in life which also includes nurturing the mother-earth which unconditionally nurtures all of us. Environmental studies shall be taught in this vertical.

Expert Tips: Covid19 pandemic taught us the importance of clean green environment, conservation and protection of natural resources and importance of oxygen. We must love our environment.

Indian Knowledge System (IKS)

This vertical connects you back to your roots.

It aims at educating the youth today to the rich heritage of our country and traditional knowledge in the field of Arts and literature, Agriculture, Basic sciences, Engineering and Technology Architecture, Management, Economics etc. If it is well preserved and widely disseminated, this knowledge can help in further research and societal applications.

Introduction

It has been a long-felt necessity to align higher education with the emerging needs of the economy so as to ensure that the graduates of higher education system have adequate knowledge and skills for employment and entrepreneurship. The higher education system has to incorporate the requirements

of various industries in its curriculum, in an innovative and flexible manner while developing a holistic and well-groomed graduate.

Ministry of HRD, Government of India had issued an Executive Order in September 2011 for National Vocational Education Qualification Framework (NVEQF). Subsequently, Ministry of Finance, in pursuance of the decision of Cabinet Committee on Skill Development in its meeting held on 19th December, 2013, has issued a notification for National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF) which supersedes NVEQF.

Under the National Skills Development Corporation, many Sector Skill Councils representing respective industries have/are being established. One of the mandates of Sector Skill Councils is to develop National Occupational Standards (NOSs) for various job roles in their respective industries. It is important to embed the competencies required for specific job roles in the higher education system for creating employable graduates.

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has launched a scheme on skills development based higher education as part of college/university education, leading to Bachelor of Vocation (B.Voc.) Degree with multiple exits such as Diploma/Advanced Diploma under the NSQF. The B.Voc. programme is focused on universities and colleges providing undergraduate studies which would also incorporate specific job roles and their NOSs along with broad based general education. 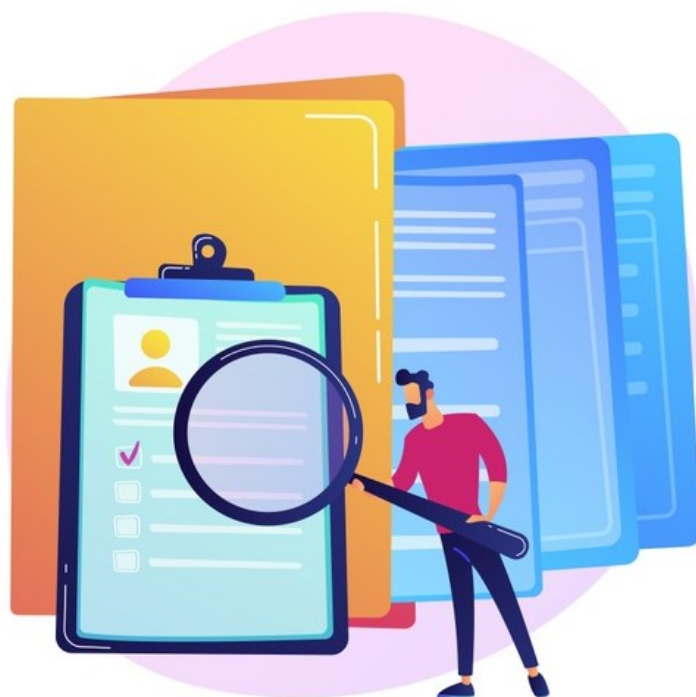

DEGREE COLLEGE

- i. Students who have passed the Higher Secondary Certificate (H.S.C.) Examination conducted by the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education, Pune are eligible for admission to the F.Y.B.A./B.Sc. /B.Com./BMS.(Subject to fulfilling the other conditions).
- ii. Students who have passed the H.S.C. or equivalent examination of any other Board, must produce an eligibility certificate issued by the Eligibility section, University of Mumbai, Kalina, Mumbai - 400 098.

DOCUMENT & CERTIFICATES



A. DOCUMENTS ISSUED BY THE COLLEGE

1. Bonafide Certificate:

Students who are admitted to the Junior or Degree College are eligible to get a bonafide certificate on application and payment of Rs.20/- (Rupees Twenty only.)

2. Railway Concession:

Only bonafide students of the college for the academic year (male students below 25 years and all lady students) are eligible for Railway concession for their season tickets between the stations nearest to their home and Ghatkopar. The student has to apply in a prescribed form of application available at the college office between 9.30 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on any working day. Long Journey Railway Concession is granted only for the vacation period according to rules of the Railways for commuting to their native places as mentioned in their admission forms.

3. Transcript:

Students seeking transcripts are required to apply on a plain paper giving full details (Marksheets and relevant documents) to the Principal. Following the verification of the documents and payment of Rs.1000/- to the cashier, four copy of the transcript will be provided.

4. Transfer Certificate:

The rules for issuing Transfer Certificate are as per the ordinance given below:

- 0.131** If, as a result of a student leaving one college to join another, it will be necessary for him to count the attendance kept by him in more than one college to enable him to make up the necessary number of attendance, a Transfer certificate shall not be granted except for reasons which appear to the executive council to be sufficient and except with the written permission of the Principal of the college which he intends to join. Provided, however, that in the event of a student leaving one college to join another after the completion of a term, or terms, it will be necessary for him to obtain the written permission from the Principal of the college which he desires to leave and the Principal of the college which he intends to join.
- 0.132** Student shall make application of Transfer Certificate without unnecessary delay through the Principal of the college to which they wish to be transferred.

5. Recommendation Letter:

Student applying for post graduate courses to Indian or Foreign Universities may apply on a plain paper giving the purpose for which the recommendation letter is sought and other personal and academic details and the name of faculty from whom such a letter is sought. The Principal on scrutiny of the application will issue relevant instructions to the office to do the needful.

6. College Examination Grade Card (Marksheets):

Students of First, Second and Third Year Degree College will be issued marksheets for Semesters I, II, III, IV, V and VI examinations as per choice based credit system.

For Students of Postgraduate program marksheets will be issued for Semesters I, II, III and IV.

7. College Leaving Certificate:

Students who have passed XIIth standard examination will be issued a college leaving certificate.

B. DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED BY THE STUDENT

1. Provisional Eligibility:

A student from another University or Board of Secondary or Intermediate Education or any other statutory examining body, seeking admission to this University/College shall apply to the Registrar, University of Mumbai for a certificate of eligibility. Such students will not be admitted to any class, if they have not obtained the provisional certificate of Eligibility from the Registrar, University of Mumbai.

After being admitted to the college on the basis of the provisional eligibility certificate, the students have to obtain final confirmation and eligibility for which they will be required to submit the following certificates in original along with a certified xerox copy.

- Original Mark Sheet
- Original Passing Certificate
- Original Migration Certificate.

Those students whose admission is provisional should note that if the Registrar does not finally confirm their admission, their terms will be treated as 'Null and Void' and they will not be allowed to appear for the final examination. Foreign students will have to show documentary evidence of conversion of their visa in addition to the above condition for eligibility.

2. Caste Certificate for Validation:

It is applicable only to students belonging to S.C/S.T. /V.J./N.T./O.B.C. /S.B.C./Nav Buddha who wish to take admission in professional colleges after passing H.S.C. examination. For the validation of the above certificates, the student has to submit original caste certificate along with two attested xerox copies and a copy of caste certificate of any of his/her close relative and attested Xerox copy of first and last page of ration-card on or before 15th October 2021.

3. Migration Certificate:

When a student of Mumbai University, either enrolled in an affiliated college or registered with the University wishes to leave the University to join any other University/Board for pursuing any course of study, he has to obtain a migration certificate from this University. A Student is required to apply in the prescribed form for the migration certificate to the Registrar of the University through the Principal of the college/institution last attended by him.

The application for migration certificate has to be accompanied by the Transfer Certificate in original and a copy thereof.

A duplicate copy of the migration certificate will not be issued under any circumstances.

If for any reason the student fails to join the University/Board that he had proposed to join, he shall return the Migration Certificate issued to him within three months from the date of issue of the migration certificate for cancellation through the Principal of the college/institution through which he applied for the migration certificate.

4. Transfer Certificate:

The rules for submitting Transfer Certificate to the college are as per the ordinance given below:

- 0.126** No Student shall at any time be admitted to any other college unless he/she produces Transfer Certificate from the College he/she leaves.
- 0.120** The Principal shall be entitled to charge a fee of Rs.100/- for issuing a Transfer Certificate. Subject to the provisions of ordinance 130, when a Principal receives an application for a Transfer Certificate more than a month after the opening of a term, he/she may levy an additional fee of Rs.20/- per term that has lapsed since the applicant attended the college, provided however that the fee charged under the ordinance shall not exceed Rs.200/- in the aggregate.

DEGREE COLLEGE

The Rules (Ordinance 2859) relating to refund of fees after cancellation of admission as per the **University of Mumbai Circular No. UG/412 of 2008 dated 11.09.2008** is given below:

The candidates who have taken admission in under graduate courses in aided and unaided courses conducted by affiliated Colleges may request for refund of fees after applying in writing for cancellation of their admission to the course. The refund of fees as applicable shall be made on or before 30th day after the date of cancellation and thereafter.

Table for fee deduction on cancellation of Admission

1.	Prior to commencement of academic term and instruction of the course	Rs.500/- lump sum
2.	Upto 20 days after the commencement of academic term of the course	20% of the total amount of fees

4.	From 51 st day upto 80 days after commencement of the academic term of the course.	50% of the total amount of fees
5.	From 81 st day to 110 days	60% of the total amount of fees
6.	After 111 day	100% of the total amount of fees

- *Refund of fees at the time of cancellation will be made only in cheque/online bank transfer after thirty working days.*
- *Cheque/online bank transfer will be in the name of Student/Parent.*

Note: The total amount considered for the refund of fees from the commencement of academic term of the courses includes the following:

- a) All the fee items chargeable for one year are as per relevant University circulars for different Faculties.
- b) The fee charged towards group insurance and all fee components to be paid as University share (including Vice-Chancellor fund, University fee for Sports and Cultural activities, E-charge, E-suvidha, Disaster Management Fund, Examination fee and Enrollment fee) are nonrefundable if the payment is made by the College to the University prior to the date of cancellation.
- c) Fees collected for Identity card and Library card, Admission Form and Prospectus, Enrollment and any other course specific fee are not refundable after the commencement of the academic term.
- d) All refundable deposits (Laboratory, Caution Money and Library etc.) shall be fully returned at the time of cancellation.

Important instructions for Reserve Category student:

Eligible Reserve Category students who are admitted to the College on payment of concessional fees prescribed by the University of Mumbai are informed that, on cancellation of admission they will be required to pay additional amount depending on the period and percentage of deduction charges of the total fees prescribed for the course.

GENERAL RULES

1. Every student must possess an Identity Card and Library Card. A fees of Rs.150/- will be collected along with other fees at the time of admission towards the cost of these cards. As soon as College reopens each student will be issued an Identity Card and a Library Card. Students must affix a recent passport size photograph on each of these cards.
2. During College hours every student must wear the lanyard carrying their Identity Card and must produce it whenever he/she is called upon to do so by the authorities.
3. Students are expected to attend lectures/practicals/tutorials regularly and should not remain absent without permission from the Principal. Attendance will be taken daily during lectures/practical/tutorials. Students who are irregular in attendance, and whose progress in various college tests/examinations is not satisfactory will not be granted their terms.

N.B: The attention of students is drawn to Ordinance 0.119 and 0.115 of the University of Mumbai which are reproduced below:

University Ordinance 0.119

In the Faculty of Arts / Science / Commerce the minimum attendance for keeping terms will be three-fourths of the days on which lectures/practical's are conducted.

University Ordinance 0.115

1. To keep a term at a College, a student must complete to the satisfaction of the Principal the courses of the studies prescribed for that term of the class to which the undergraduate belongs.
2. Students are expected to maintain proper discipline in the class as well as within the College premises and ensure that no disturbance is caused to fellow students of the other classes.
3. Students shall not indulge in anything inside or outside the College that will in any way interfere with its discipline.
4. Student shall not loiter in the corridors while the classes are in progress.
5. Students should help in keeping the college premises tidy and should not damage any property of the college by disfiguring walls, doors, fittings & furniture etc.

6. Students should not communicate any information to the press or write in the press about any matter concerning the college without the permission of the Principal.
7. If for any reason, the continuance of a student in the college is found to be detrimental to the best interest of the college in the opinion of the Principal, he/she will be asked to leave the college.
8. Government or College Scholarship/Free Studentship will be granted only to such student who are regular in attendance and whose conduct and progress are satisfactory.
9. It is the responsibility of students to see notice boards regularly and fill up the respective forms for freeships/scholarships from government. Students changing from one College to another will be required to produce a No Objection Certificate from the Principal of the College previously attended as well as from Director of Education and/or Social Welfare Officer.
10. Smoking/Chewing Pan/Tobacco and Spitting are strictly prohibited in the college.
11. Matters not covered by the existing rules will rest at the discretion of the Principal.

EXAMINATION & EVALUATION



F.Y./S.Y./ T.Y. B.A./B.Com./B.Sc. Degree College Examination

In 2011, University of Mumbai has introduced Credit Based Semester and Grading System (CBSGS) for Degree College students and is applicable to the students (learners) admitted (enrolled) for Undergraduate and Postgraduate degree programs under the faculties of Arts, Science & Commerce. It is applicable to both traditional & self-financing undergraduate and postgraduate degree programs for all three faculties of Arts, Science & Commerce. From the academic year 2018-19, the college has been granted 'Autonomous College affiliated to Mumbai University' status jointly by University Grants Commission, New Delhi and University of Mumbai. The following rules and regulations are applicable for the academic assessment of the students.

1. In every semester, the College will conduct three assessments for all theory courses. Two Internal Assessments (IA1) and (IA2), each of 20 marks. Thus, 40% of the total marks per course will be evaluated through continuous evaluation method.
2. One Semester End Examination (SEE) of 60 marks for the duration of 2 hours, for the remaining 60% of the total marks of the said course.
3. Learner (student) must appear at least one IA Examination to be eligible for appearing for SEE. In other words, a student who has appeared for IA1 or IA2 or both can ONLY appear for SEE.
4. There will be no retests for the IAs. Every student must appear for SEE. Any student who misses either IA1 or IA2 should acquire the 40% required to pass the course through the combination IA attended and SEE.

5. If a student fails to score 40% in the overall total in a given paper of any course, such a student will have to appear for the 60 marks Examination in the next academic year and his/her score of IA1 and/or IA2 will remain valid for Six years (inclusive of the year of Enrollment).
6. For Science Program, the Practical component per course is for 50 marks in each paper. FYBSc (2 Course /Semester), SYBSc (3 Course / Semester) and TYBSc (4 main Course and 1 applied component / Semester).
7. In science faculty, to clear Practical Examination, a student is required to secure a minimum of 40% of the total marks allotted for the practicals in the said course. Appearing for individual practical is mandatory.
8. At any of the post graduate courses, a student is required to obtain a minimum of 16 out of 40 marks in Internal examination and minimum 24 out of 60 marks in External examination (together 40% of the total marks allotted to that course).
9. The facility for obtaining Duplicate copy of the Grade Card is available to all learners. The learner shall apply to Examination Cell (EC) in a prescribed form and pay the fees towards the duplicate copy as per University Circular No. Cert/1854 of 2006. EC would require 7 working days, starting from the date of application.
10. For the details regarding passing standards, Gracing rules, ATKT rules, verification and photocopy rules, performance grade calculation chart, SGPA and CGPA calculations and relevant ordinances to that effect can be obtained from the college website.
11. Student seeking admission in R J College is also advised to regularly visit collegewebsite for all examination related notices and announcements.
12. All rules and regulations mentioned above are subject to change as per updates and announcements received from UGC, Mumbai University, and State Government Authorities.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND FREESHIPS



Students who have sought concession in fees on the basis of Scholarship/Freeship but failed to fill the Scholarship/Freeship form before the due date or were not eligible for the Scholarship/Freeship will have to pay the balance fees.

ELIGIBILITY FOR SCHOLARSHIP/FREESHIP:

- For SC/ST income limit for Scholarship is below 2,00,000/-
- For OBC/VJNT/SBC income limit for Scholarship is below 1,00,000/-
- For SC/ST income limit for Freeship is above 2,00,000/-
- For VJNT/SBC/OBC income limit for Freeship is above 1,00,000/- up to 4,50,000/-
- All Freeship & Scholarship Students have to open Student Account with Corporation Bank, Ghatkopar (W) Branch for online disbursement of amount from the Government, failing which the Scholarship will not be granted
- Students must write Mobile / Contact Number in the application form.
- The college will not be responsible for any claim under Freeship / Scholarship in case students do not submit the required documents by 31st July of the academic year or the claim is rejected by Govt. such students will have to pay full fees of the academic year.
- Students who have been admitted from other than Maharashtra State are not eligible to receive fees concession.
- Students can only avail of any one scholarship or freeship from only one course or department of Government Authorities.

LIBRARY, READING ROOM & STUDY CENTRE



CAMPUS LIBRARY

The College also runs a Study Centre which provides facilities to students of other Colleges residing in/near Ghatkopar. The Library and study Centre are closed on Sundays and Public Holidays. From January onwards both the library and Study Centre are kept open on Sundays and most holidays between 10.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. The library is computerized to facilitate quick searching of books. Free internet facility is available for students. Additional reading rooms are open 24 hours from February to May.

RULES PERTAINING TO THE LIBRARY

1. While entering the library, students should carry both, their Identity Card as well as Library Card.
2. Students will ensure that they do not disturb other students in the Library.
3. Books are issued for home reading for a period of one week only against demand slip (duty filed and signed) on days notified for this purpose. Reference Books and prescribed text books kept in the reading hall, Dictionaries, Encyclopedias, Atlases and other classified as reference books must be used in the library only during working hours.
4. Students should desist from marking library books with pencil or ink or mutilating them. Books found damaged/mutilated must be brought to the notice of librarian at time of issue, failing which the last reader will be held responsible for the same. Students found damaging/mutilating

books, periodicals will be required to compensate for the damage. Further, at the discretion of the librarian, such student may not avail of library facilities thereafter.

5. Students who have enrolled through the College as post graduate students will be required to pay library deposit of Rs.400/- for borrowing books for home reading.
6. Students failing to return books issued for home reading on or before the due date will be liable to pay a fine of Rs. 15/- per day till such time as the book is returned.
7. Students will not be issued more than one book at a time for home reading. While returning books students will ensure that the necessary entry of return is made in his/her presence.
8. Books issued against the Identity card are for use in the Reading Hall only and must be returned while leaving the library. Disciplinary action will be taken against students violating this rule.
9. The Students are required to maintain silence in the Reading Hall.
10. *All Departments have departmental Library with open access.*

GYMKHANA

The activities of the Gymkhana are managed by the Gymkhana Managing Committee under the sole charge of a senior member of the staff as its Chairperson responsible for co-ordinating the activities in various fields of sports, both-indoor and outdoor. Each game/department is directly controlled by a staff member as a Sports Director, and a student secretary.

Since the College does not have its own playground, arrangements are made to hire grounds/playing fields in different localities for each game.

Expert coaches are appointed whenever necessary to train students in different games. College celebrates Annual Sports Day. Provision exists to admit outstanding sportsmen/women and incentives are provided to such players by way of sports scholarship /free ship. College colours are awarded for outstanding performances on the field.



NATIONAL CADET CORPS (N.C.C)

The College enrolls students for the Senior Division N.C.C. under the 6th Maharashtra Bn N.C.C. ANTI RAGGING SQUAD

The College has an Anti-Ragging Squad and Anti-Ragging Committee. Ragging is totally banned in the college. Ragging would be met with exemplary punishment. A Student found guilty of ragging earlier will not be admitted. The college strictly follows all the regulations as mentioned in the ***"Coregulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions,2009"***. All students will give an undertaking that he or she is aware of the law regarding prohibition of ragging as well as the punishments, and that he/she if found guilty of the offence of ragging and /or abetting ragging is liable to be punished appropriately. A similar undertaking shall be taken from the parents that they are also aware of the law in this regard.

Students and parents are informed that ragging is banned and shall be considered as a serious offence which will attract severe punishment. Parents are requested to emphasize on their wards the seriousness of the offence and instruct them not to indulge in ragging.

UGC REGULATIONS ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, 2009 (under Section 26 (1) (g) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956) Full text is available on our website, www.rjcollege.edu.in

Important aspects of the Regulation are given below:

1. **What constitutes Ragging:** Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:
 - a. any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student;
 - b. indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student;
 - c. asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student;
 - d. any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
 - e. exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students,
 - f. any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
 - g. any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;
 - h. any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student;
 - i. any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student.
2. **Action to be taken by the Head of the Institution:** On receipt of the recommendation of the Anti-Ragging Squad or on receipt of any information concerning any reported incident of ragging, the Head of institution shall immediately determine if a case under the penal laws is made out and if so, either on his own or through a member of the Anti-Ragging Committee authorized by him in this behalf, proceed to file a First Information Report (FIR), within twenty four hours of receipt of such information or recommendation, with the police and local

authorities, under the appropriate penal provisions mentioned in the *“UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009”*.

3. **Administrative action in the event of ragging:** The institution shall punish a student found guilty of ragging after following the procedure mentioned in the *“UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009”*.

2. A field trips shall not be arranged without the written permission of the Principal. Request for arranging field trips should be made in the proforma provided for this purpose. All Field Trips will be permitted only if a suitable number of teachers accompany the students. Lady students will be permitted to join the trips / picnics only if a lady member of the teaching staff accompanies them.
3. Class “Social” and “Get Together” may be permitted provided the Principal is satisfied that such function is being organized under the guidance / supervision of a staff member and the function does not disturb the normal teaching schedule of the College.
4. The College celebrates its Annual Festival called “Reflections”- an intercollegiate fest.

CONTINUITY OF EDUCATION DURING CRISIS

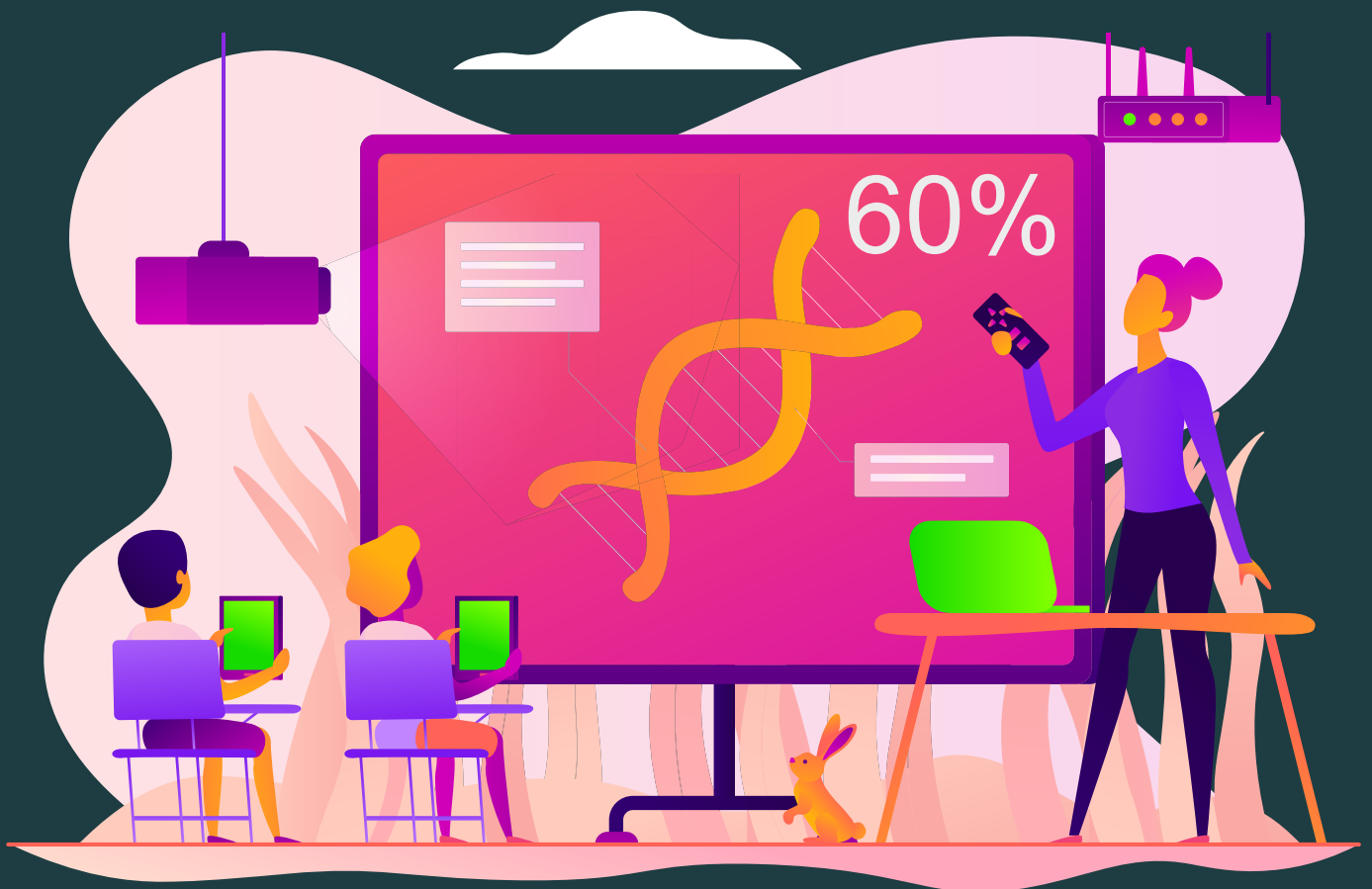

16. Conduct of laboratory sessions and contact classrooms as soon as normalcy returns ensuring all precautionary measures are in place

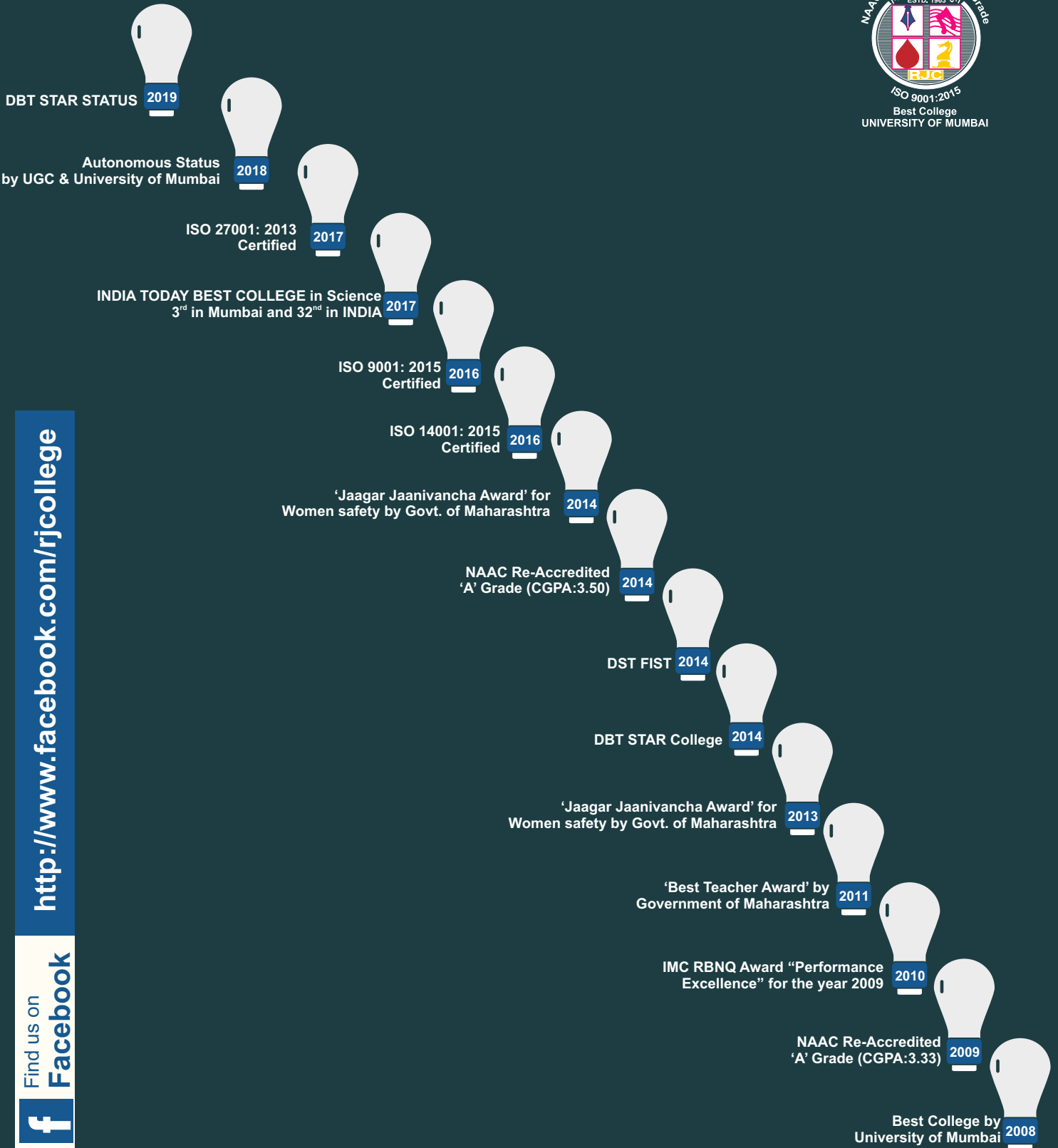
