Chemistry Department Minutes of BOS Meeting held on Thursday, 29th September 2022

- Offline meeting of all the members of Board of Studies was convened by the BOS Chairman & Head of Chemistry Department, Dr. R. S. Dubey on Thursday, 29th September 2022 at 01.30 pm. The list of BOS members present in the meeting is attached overleaf.
 - In the beginning, the Chairman welcomed all the members of BOS and placed the agenda for the deliberations of the members. Following deliberations were made as per the items of circulated agenda.
 - Approval of minutes of last BOS meeting held on Saturday, 26th Feb 2022 was obtained by the chairman. Chairman then presented a power point presentation regarding current academic status of the department. An overview of various cocurricular activities conducted by the department till date is also given by the chairman.
 - 2. No change in T.Y. B.Sc. Chemistry syllabus of Sem V & Sem VI was proposed by all members of revision committee and it was approved by the BOS members.
 - 3. Introduction of DSE for sem. III & sem. IV at S.Y.B.Sc. level with two credits each.
 - 4. Revised credit pattern for T.Y.B.Sc. to be implemented from academic year 2023-24, was discussed at length and following suggestions by different B.O.S. members were gathered:
 - a) External members, Dr S. D. Samant and Dr. Brijesh Singh suggested to increase the no. of existing credits per paper of theory syllabus to meet with the requirements of U.G.C. They also felt the serious need to increase the no. of credits per practical paper of the syllabus, based on the actual contact hours.
 - b) Members also suggested to check the possibility of considering the subject of applied component as Discipline Subject Component (DSC).
 - c) All the B.O.S. members also felt the need to remove the newly introduced DSC at S.Y.B.Sc. level for allotting additional credits but to increase the no. of already existing credits per paper as per UGC norms.
 - 3. Chairman proposed an idea of introducing an internship for entire 4th semester at M.Sc. part II course in all the available branches of chemistry in the college.
