Suggestions given in the meeting:

SUGGESTION FOR GEOGRAPHY:-

- 1) The BOS members had no suggestion for changes in SYBA syllabus for the year 2023-24. All the members have approved of the examination pattern of blended mode. The Semester End Examination Pattern was also approved by the members for SYBA Geography papers.
- 2) Suggestions for FYBA, Generic Elective was discussed by BOS Members and topics like Geography of Sustainable Development for Semester I and Urban Liveability for Semester II was initiated.
- 3) Other topics discussed were simple geography of maps, calculation of time, knowledge about Lithosphere, Atmosphere and Hydrosphere, Concept of Environment, Geography around us, Bio-Geo cycles, World Happiness Index etc.
- 4) For Skill Enhancement course contents like Basics of Maps, GIS Technology, Green Auditing, Ecological Footprint Assessment, EIA etc. can make the subject more valuable.

SUGGESTION FOR EVS:-

- 1) The revised syllabus was discussed in details and all members approved of it for the academic year 2022-23.
- 2) Discussion on NEP 2020 was taken ahead by pointing out to provide Environmental Education to be taken up as Generic Electives of 4 credits in Semester I in Bcom. Topics which can be taken up includes Ecology, Urban Health, Environmental Issues and Environmental Tools.
- 3) Members stressed on Value Added Courses for future careers. Members also stressed on the importance of the awareness of Environmental Instruments to develop life skills in students.
- 4) Workshops and Value Added Courses related to ISO Certifications, Carbon footprint calculation, Green Audit etc. was suggested.
- 5) The Members stressed on to wait for university circular to make the syllabus concretely.
- 6) Semester II will have 2 Credits for Environment made compulsorily in BA/BCOM/BSC classes. UGC syllabus guidelines have to be followed.
