Madam,

This has reference to your letter No. 497, dated 3rd July, 2004, requesting permission to start M.Sc. degree course by papers in the subject of Bio-Technology from the academic year 2005-2006.

In this connection, I am directed to inform you that considering the permission granted by Higher and Technical Education Department of Government of Maharashtra, and as admission for all post-graduate courses is required to be completed by the end of the June 2005, your college has been permitted to start M.Sc. degree course by papers in the subject of Bio-Technology from the academic year 2005-2006 in exercise of the powers conferred upon Vice-chancellor under 14(7) of the Maharashtra Universities Act 1994 on permanent no grant basis subject to satisfactory report of Local Inquiry Committee appointed by the University and also on the following conditions.

1. Permission has been granted to enroll 20 students only.
2. Reservation Policy of the Government and the University should be strictly followed.
3. The fee for the course should be charged as prescribed by the University.
4. The decision of the University on the report of the Local Inquiry Committee to be appointed for the purpose will be binding on your college.
5. Admission of the students to this course should be made as per the criteria laid down in Ordinances relating to eligibility criteria and in accordance with procedure prescribed by the University.
6. The college shall follow the guidelines issued by the University vide Circular No.PG/1/ 2170/ of 2005, dated 22nd June, 2005 and Circular No.PG/1/ 2232/ of 2005, dated 24th June, 2005 (copies enclosed).

You are therefore, requested to submit the necessary undertaking stating that your college will fulfill the above conditions.
