CIRCULAR:

The head of the University Department of Computer Science, Co-ordinator of University Department of information Technology and the Principals of affiliated colleges enrolling the students for M.Sc. degree course in the subject of Computer Science and Information Technology are hereby informed that the following norms are required to be followed while making the admission for M.Sc. degree course in Computer Science and Information Technology.

1. Batch size should be 10 seats.
2. The total number of seats for Computer Science and Information Technology should not exceed 40 and 20 respectively or as permitted by the University whichever is less.
3. For every batch of 10 students not more than 3 students are to be admitted against in house quota and remaining Seven Seats per batch of 10 students are to be filled against general quota.
4. 50% seats are for reserved category students both, in-house and general merit quota respectively.
5. All seats should be filled strictly on merit in the respective categories.
6. Reservation policy of Government and University should be strictly followed.
7. The fee for the course should be charged as prescribed by the University Viz. Computer Science – Rs. 15,000/- and Information Technology – Rs. 25,000/-.
