EXECUTION:

1. CC will give due acknowledgement to student participation in the plethora of extension activities being organized on R J Campus for student support.
2. Enrollment of students to NSS/NCC/Rotaract/ DLLE/ SES-REC/Safai Bank/Cultural/ Sports etc. will open.
3. Departments will introduce the departmental activities/ Departmental festivals/Signature activities of the departmental and promote student participation through different roles offered like organizing the event, conduct of the event, logistics, guest relation, talent hunt etc.
4. CC Workbook will be provided to each student.
5. Student participation in different Intra- and Inter-collegiate events will be recorded in the books of individual students by respective departments on a weekly basis. Every department must ensure to issue a certificate of participation to each eligible student.
6. Certificates of participation, prizes won, awards conferred on the students and other achievements of the students including cultural and sports will be mapped under NEP Performance Index.
7. Student engagement in any value added course such as SAP (Self Awareness Program) or CEP (Community Engagement Program) or Societal Outreach Program (SOP) such as education of poor children, awareness campaign, street play for social harmony or helping Railways , Police and BMC in maintaining the harmony during the festival celebrations, beautification of the public places, cleanliness of the public places, vaccination and blood donation drive or providing helping hand in natural calamities such as floods and landslide shall all suffice as the partial fulfillment of this vertical.
